- 83% of students at SBHS are involved in an activity or club. (This was reported to the Board at the 8/19/15 meeting by the Director of Student Activities).
- Attached is a list of the co-curricular positions which oversee the student activities and athletics. (This is from the labor contract now in place).
- In the past few years, there have been several additions to this list including the D.E.C.A. Club, Bowling, Volleyball, Ultimate Frisbee, and several other opportunities.
- There are 157 people involved in the oversight of these activities.
- The responsibilities of some of these positions are spilt between two or more people.
- Some coaches/advisors have oversight of more than one sport or activity.
- The total cost of Wages and FICA/MEDIFICA for these positions amounts to \$625,178. There are no benefits provided.
- In addition, there are other associated costs including bus driver compensation, fuel, and the cost of umpires and officials.
