The legal voters of the City of South Burlington School District are hereby notified and warned to meet at their respective polling places at the Frederick H. Tuttle Middle School on Dorset Street, the Orchard School on Baldwin Avenue and the Chamberlin School on White Street on Thursday, April 6, 2017, at 7:00 o'clock in the morning, at which time the polls will open, until 7:00 o'clock in the evening, at which time the polls will close, to vote by Australian ballot on the following article:

BUDGET


Shall the voters of the City of South Burlington School District approve the School Board to expend FORTY NINE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED NINETY AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$49,754,590.00), which is the amount the School Board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$15,575.76 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 3.48% higher than spending for the current year.




