



SOUTH BURLINGTON HIGH SCHOOL 2021-2022 Winter Guidelines

Vaccination: We strongly recommend all eligible student-athletes get vaccinated. Vaccination is a proven mitigation strategy and will ultimately ensure athletes can stay in school and compete safely throughout the season. ***It is important to note that if a COVID + case turns up on a team only the infected student and any unvaccinated student-athletes will experience any disruption to their season.***

Masks: Will be worn by student-athletes, coaching staff, referees, and spectators ***any time they are inside a building or on a bus.*** This includes during indoor practices, competitions, games, **and team activities that take place on or off-campus.** regardless of individual vaccination status, except for the following limited circumstance:

- Athletes participating in running events - both practice sessions and meets/competitions (so long as physical distancing is maintained).

Spectators: No limits on the number of spectators. All spectators **MUST** be **MASKED** at all times.

- If an individual spectator needs to be reminded about masking expectations more than one time that person will be asked to leave and will not be able to attend future games.
- If the task of monitoring masking compliance becomes a challenge to site administrators, South Burlington High School will be forced to no longer allow fans.
