Eligibility: High school senior applying to college, undergraduate or graduate college students, must be son or daughter of Vermont-NEA members, preference given to those majoring in education, award based on merit.

Deadline: **RECEIVED BY 11:59 p.m. Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>**

Amount: 10- \$1000 scholarships

Requirement: Essay (under 400 words in length): This year's essay question is: *"Student activism has increased in recent years. Describe a time when you were inspired by students taking a stand or a time when you participated in student activism. What inspired you? Why was the action important?"* Also 2 letters of recommendation, transcript, list of co-curricular and community service activities.

## **Robert J. Sheridan Memorial Scholarship (sponsored through VT Elks Association)**

- Eligibility: High school senior who is a U.S. citizen and plans to pursue a career in physical education.
- Deadline: **Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>**
- Amount: Two scholarships awarded annually, one each to a male and female student, amount TBD (will be in excess of \$500)
- Requirement: Transcript, SAT/ACT scores, 2 letters of recommendation (one from school personnel, one from coach), essay about plans after graduating from college, summarization of family's financial obligations and resources. Application must be submitted to Scholarship Chairperson, B.P.O.E. #916, 925 North Avenue, Burlington, VT 05408.

## **New England Red Sox Service Scholarship Program for Vermont**

- Eligibility: High school senior who is a legal VT resident, pursuing a two-year or four-year degree at college, university or trade school. Applicants will be selected based on academic performance, demonstrated community service and eligibility for financial aid.
- Deadline: **Feb. 7<sup>th</sup>** (you must apply before the deadline to accommodate guidance office's time to upload transcripts/letter of recommendations)
- Amount: \$1000 (guaranteed for one student from SBHS)

- Requirement: Application, teacher letter of recommendation, letter from doctor overseeing your care, transcript, essay describing how you have coped with your disability or debilitating illness, including some of your biggest achievements, college acceptance letter, financial need form

## **Knights of Columbus Scholastic Achievement Awards**

- Eligibility: High school senior whose parent is a Knight of Columbus. Children of a deceased member are also eligible. Applicant may be member of Knights of Columbus or Columbian Squires Circle.
- Deadline: **Mar. 10<sup>th</sup>**
- Amount: Five \$1000 scholarships are awarded this year
- Requirement: Recommendation, transcript, handwritten essay

## **Alice Angney Scholarship for Leadership and Service**

- Amount: \$3000
- Requirements: Application, transcript, essay, two letters of recommendation

## **The St. Andrew's Society of Vermont Scholarship Foundation Academic Scholarships:**

- Eligibility: VT resident or St. Andrew's Society of Vermont members and their families, who will enroll or who are already enrolled in an associate's or a bachelor's degree program.
- Deadline: **RECEIVED BY 5:00 pm Mar. 28<sup>th</sup>**
- Amount: Three (3) to five (5) \$1000 academic scholarships
- Requirement: Scholastic record, 3 letters of recommendation, a letter of educational goals, financial need, and SAT scores.

## South Burlington Friends of the Arts Scholarship

- Deadline: **Mar. 31<sup>st</sup> (if mailing, must be postmarked by Mar. 28<sup>th</sup>)**
- Amount: \$1000
- Requirement: Application, one letter of recommendation, current photo

## B.P.O.E #916 Scholarship Program

- Eligibility: High school senior, who is a U.S. citizen and child, step-child, grandchild, step-grandchild or a legal wards of a member local Burlington B.P.O.E. Lodge #916

- Amount: \$1000
- Requirement: Transcript, SAT and/or ACT scores, confidential counselor's report and school profile in a sealed envelope, 500 words or less essay (*"Using one of the leadership roles or extracurricular activities you prioritized as being important to you, describe what impact the experience had on you, what you contributed, what you learned about yourself, and how it has influenced your plans for the future."*). Punctuation and spelling are important. Typewritten applications are preferred.
