## Coca Cola Scholars Foundation Scholarship

Eligibility: High school seniors who demonstrate a capacity to lead and serve, and are committed to making a significant impact on their school and community. Must be planning to pursue a degree at a postsecondary institution, have a minimum GPA of 3.0, be a US citizen, US National, US Permanent Resident, Refugee, Asylee, Cuban-Haitian Entrant or Humanitarian Parolee.

Deadline: **Oct. 31<sup>st</sup>**

Amount: \$20,000

## Elks National Foundation Most Valuable Student Scholarship

Eligibility: Senior who is a U.S. citizen, and demonstrates leadership, academic achievement and financial need. Does not need to belong to the Elks.

Deadline: **Nov. 15<sup>th</sup>**

Amount: 500 four-year awards, ranging from \$1000 to \$12,500 per year

## Choose Vermont Scholarship

Eligibility: Student must commit to attend full-time a Vermont college or university and between January 1, 2022 and June 1, 2022. The student must be attending college for the first time. Completed entry form may be submitted only once. Winners are randomly selected after enrollment in the Vermont college is confirmed.

Deadline: Entries accepted **between Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> and June 1<sup>st</sup>**

Amount: Fourteen \$5000 scholarships are available

Requirement: Transcript, SAT and/or ACT scores, confidential counselor's report and school profile in a sealed envelope, 500 words or less essay (*"Using one of the leadership roles or extracurricular activities you prioritized as being important to you, describe what impact the experience had on you, what you contributed, what you learned about yourself, and how it has influenced your plans for the future."*). Punctuation and spelling are important. Typewritten applications are preferred.
